It also does not set up mail settings or configure system security so you will have to do those separately. You can use the script as a reference if you're installing on a non-fresh machine.

wget
https://codeberg.org/bookstack/devops/raw/b
ranch/main/scripts/installation-ubuntu-
24.04.sh

# Make it executable
chmod a+x installation-ubuntu-24.04.sh

sudo ./installation-ubuntu-24.04.sh
```
